Azle City-Wide clean up & recycling event

The City of Azle, in partnership with Community Waste Disposal (CWD), will conduct a **FREE** city-wide clean-up. Residents can drop off brush, furniture, bulky items, appliances, metal for recycling and small amounts of construction materials from do-it-yourself projects.

CWD will be on site to collect Household Hazardous Waste (paints, chemicals, cleaners, used motor oil and batteries), used tires and E*waste (computers, printers, electronic devices, old television sets). A document shredder will be on site for any sensitive documents.

We ask you pre-sort as much as possible; this helps keep traffic moving and allows our staff to work as efficiently as possible. This is a *free* event for Azle residents (**who reside inside the city limits**) and proof of Azle residency is required by presenting your utility bill and drivers license.

Items Not Accepted: Ammunition, asbestos, building materials, butane cylinders, explosives, medical waste, PCBs, propane cylinders, radioactive material, smoke detectors, or watercraft.

Free recycled paint for Azle residents

City of Azle and CWD have worked together to create a recycled paint program by blending the usable paint collected at Azle's X-Treme Green Events and offering the recycled paint (latex & oil-based) FREE to Azle residents. Paint is available in 1-gallon containers and comes in various shades of beige (limit 2 gallons per household). The City of Azle does not guarantee the purity, quality, consistency, etc of the paint distributed. Paint is available at Azle City Hall, 613 SE Parkway, from 8 am - 5 pm, Monday-Friday.
